WHY ARE WE DOING IT?! WHAT DO WE WANT TO GET OUT OF IT?

- Enabling cross-border / cross-institution resource discovery i.e. finding data
- Enabling interoperability across partners, countries, data types, data schemas i.e. enabling research

HOW WILL WE MEASURE SUCCESS?

Quantity

- Number of records in the ARIADNE Catalogue
- Number of countries represented

Quality

- Good *meaningful* search results
- Level of granularity item level interoperability e.g. individual artefacts, not just sites; individual dates; individual graves, not just cemeteries
- Integration of new data types
- Quantity and quality of re-use i.e. new users; new research

HOW WILL WE GO ABOUT IT?

Human interface – ARIADNE portal

- ARIADNE Catalogue (AC)
 - Harvested collection level metadata, but also item level data, and ontologies
 - Links to distributed digital and paper resources
- What, When, Where searches
 - Enhanced map-based searching
- Enhanced queries, specific to data types

Machine interface – via APIs

- Mirrors what is available via the catalogue
- Makes it available as Linked Open Data
- Allows other organisations to implement their own portal or service based upon the ARIADNE AC

THE CHALLENGES

- Heterogeneity data is diverse in character and content
 - Sites
 - Reports
 - Finds
 - Datasets e.g. excavation archives
 - Now ARIADNEplus
 - more sub-domains e.g. scientific data;
 - more data types e.g. images, GIS, LiDAR
- Diverse ontologies, and vocabularies
- Multilingualism

THE SOLUTIONS

- User needs study which searches do we wish to support?
- Data availability "low hanging fruit" critical mass of item level data e.g. reports, sites, finds > "Semantic categories"
- Ontologies CIDOC-CRM to help provide an Object-Orientated data structure – shows how data types are related
- Data mappings
 - What? Getty AAT
 - When? Period0
 - Where? WGS84
- Application profiles subsets of the CRM we use for item level integration (cf ARIADNE coins)

The fortress Vishegrad is located on a rocky peak on the right bank of river Arda (dam Studen kladenets). It covers an area of 0.56 acres. The south wall is 75 meters length and wide from 1.70 to 2 m. In the eastward end and in the middle of the south wall were erected two rectangular towers. The lower floors of the towers were plastered with hydrophobic paint and served as reservoirs. In places the walls of the towers and fortress walls rise up to 8 m in height. The main entrance was from the southeast and was 2.5 meters wide and later was narrowed to 1.2 m. The castle was built in 12th century. On the foundations of an ancient fortress and probably functioned until early 15th century. The fortification facilities are well preserved; some of them have been restored.

Summary (English)

EXPLORATIONS NEAR THE VILLAGE OF POMOSHTNIK (Ventsislav Dinchev - vdintchev@abv.bg) Remains of a complex consisting of buildings and constructions spread over an area of 0.2 - 0.3 ha are situated on the site. A building with at least five rooms and an inner yard, with a total area of more than 300 sq. m and oriented northwest - southeast, was explored in the northwestern sector "A". The inner yard measures 9.80 m by 8.70 m. The foundations of the walls are constructed of uneven and roughly cut stones with a bonding medium of mud, 60 - 70 cm in thickness. Most likely, the walls were built of lath-and-plaster or boards plastered with clay. The roofs of the rooms were covered with tegulae and imbrices. The finds include nails, cramps, millstones, pottery, terracotta weights, a spindle whorl, jewelry and c. 10 copper coins (the latest one minted in AD 367 - 370). Residual finds from earlier periods were also found. The building functioned during the 4th century AD and was burned during the Gothic invasions in the AD 370s. A square fortification tower was explored in the central sector "B". Its inner size is 4.30 m by 4.30 m and its walls are c. 1.60 m in width. The foundations of the tower are built of uneven stones bonded with mortar. The walls were constructed of ashlars and their faces were plastered with mortar. The tower is synchronous to the building in sector "A". Iron slag was found in the cultural stratum between the building and the tower. It shows the existence of a forge. The architectural complex could be identified as a burgus with additional residential and farm buildings.

Mogelijk is dit gebeurd ten behoeve van de baksteenindustrie, die vooral in de Nieuwe tijd plaatsvond, maar hier zijn geen aanwijzingen voor aangetroffen. In de diepere ondergrond van het plangebied kunnen in het pleistocene oppervlak in potentie archeologische resten bevinden uit de periode vóór de IJzertijd. De diepteligging van het zand bevindt zich volgens Archisll op 2 m -NAP (ca. 12 m -mv). De intactheid van dit oppervlak is echter onbekend.

De bastions en het hoornwerk zijn aarden verdedigingswerken, die in eerste aanleg uit de 18e eeuw dateren en zijn nadien in de (jaartallen) aangepast/uitgebreid/verbeterd. In top van de ophogingslagen van deze bouwwerken worden geen archeologische waarden in situ verwacht. Wel kunnen in het gebied (op of in de top van de bastions en het hoornwerk en in de grachten) losse vondsten uit de periode vanaf de 18e eeuw tot en met de Nieuwe tijd aanwezig zijn. Deze vondsten zijn gelieerd aan de militaire functie van de Bastions en het Hoornwerk tussen de Franse tijd en de Tweede Wereldoorlog.

In het gebied worden de grachten uitgebaggerd, de scherpe belijning van de aardwerken hersteld en zal de begroeiing worden verwijderd. De kans dat door deze ingrepen (mits deze 'historisch verantwoord' plaatsvinden) de verdedigingswerken zelf en eventuele onderliggende archeologische resten worden aangetast of verstoord, wordt klein geacht. ADC ArcheoProjecten adviseert daarom om het plangebied vrij te geven voor de voorgenomen ontwikkeling. Wel wordt geadviseerd het uitbaggeren van de grachten te begeleiden. Op de bodem van de grachten kunnen vondsten aanwezig zijn, die inzicht kunnen geven aan de militaire activiteiten op en rond de verdedigingswerken. Aanbevolen wordt om bij de voorgenomen werkzaamheden de lokale amateurarcheologen of historische verenigingen te betrekken.

Het verdient daarom aanbeveling om de uitvoerder van het grondwerk te wijzen op de plicht archeologische vondsten te melden bij de bevoegde overheid, zoals aangegeven in artikel 53 van de Monumentenwet.






